

Tools and Supplies

- Tools to bring: Hot Glue Gun
- Supplies to bring:
 - Book(s) to decorate
 - Bottle(s) to decorate
 - Printed label(s) to put on bottle(s) (age by pre-soaking in tea or coffee)
 - Examples: Search for "apothecary labels" or similar
 - Painting clothes
- Provided:
 - Paints & brushes
 - Mod podge (sealer glue and finish)
 - Tissue, paper towels, stick-on letters
 - Some decorations and bottle labels
 - gloves

Steps for Books

- Decorate books using raised letters (with hot glue) & tissue paper
 - can also use hot glue alone, including glow-in-the-dark glue
- Paint book (typically black) and paint page edges sepia
- Let dry
- Dry brush and embellish

Steps for Bottles

- Paint bottle, let dry
- Glue on label(s)
- Add items such as apple cores* with plenty of hot glue
- Dry brush

* Must pre-dry for a week or two
